Participation in this event keeps our graduates free from the planned or accidental use of alcohol, tobacco and other drugs and demonstrates to them that it is possible to have a great celebration without the use of these. Most importantly the event works to prevent the tragedy that all too frequently occurs when drugs and alcohol are involved.
