

Dear Parent/Guardian:

According to the Pesticide Policy adopted by the Watertown Board of Education in April 2001, the parents/guardian of each child enrolled in the Watertown schools must be provided with a copy of the Policy each year together with a description of any pesticide applications made on school property during the previous school year. Parents may then have the option of being informed prior to any future applications.

I have been informed by the Terminix Company that, during the 2012-2013 school year, the only materials used for regular services at Watertown High School were glue boards, snap traps, and baits. These services were and will continue to be performed when students are not in the building, except in case of an emergency. Our regularly scheduled service will be on the first Friday of each month after school.

Please review the enclosed Policy. If you would like to be informed prior to any pesticide applications other than those scheduled, please complete the form below and return it to the school office.
